## RECLAMATION PLAN

**Within thirty days of the initial disturbance, the following steps will be taken; except for active work areas:**

1. All surface pits that are not needed for production purposes will be drained and filled.
2. The well location and access roads will be graded and stabilized. Culverts will be installed as needed, and dikes will be constructed if required to control water movement and protect against spills.
3. All drilling supplies and equipment, trash, discarded materials and other refuse not contained and covered in the reclaimed pits will be removed from the site.
4. Temporary Vegetative cover will then be established on all graded areas. As soon as possible, permanent vegetation will be established in accordance with the table found at Rule 1040-2-9-.05 Surface Reclamation, Section (2) Paragraph (c).

**Within thirty days of the plugging and abandonment of the well, these steps will be taken:**

1. All production and storage facilities, supplies and equipment, and any oil, salt water and debris will be removed.
2. Any remaining excavations will be filled, and any remaining disturbed areas, including access roads, will be graded.
3. Permanent vegetative cover will then be established on all disturbed areas in accordance with the table found at Rule 1040-2-9-.05 Surface Reclamation, Section (2) Paragraph (c).

The well inspector will be notified when the site is ready for final reclamation inspection.
