



ANNUAL REPORT OF COUNTRY OF MANUFACTURE FOR OIL COUNTRY TUBULAR GOODS

(REVISED 040315)

Section 1509.16 of the Ohio Revised Code requires well owners to file a disclosure form with the Division of Oil and Gas Resources Management that specifies the country of manufacture for tubular goods that are initially used in a production operation on or after March 31, 2015.

Tubular goods are defined as seamless or welded steel pipe and include casing, tubing, drill pipe and drill collars.

The linear length of all tubular goods initially used in a production operation and the country of manufacture should be entered in the appropriate box below.

The linear length of drill pipe and drill collars should be entered for each well in which they were used.

The form shall be filed with the Division on or before March 31 of each calendar year and shall specify the total length in feet of all casing, tubing, drill pipe and drill collars that were used in the owners' wells for the previous calendar year.
