The Department may classify an abandoned well as an orphan well if:

- It was abandoned before the Oil and Gas Act became effective (April 18, 1985);
- and the current owner or lessee never operated the well nor did anything to affect the well (e.g., strip equipment or re-plumb it);
- and the current owner, operator, or lessee never received any "economic benefit" (ever) from the well except as a landowner or a recipient of a royalty interest.

According to the Oil and Gas Act (58 PS 601.509(4)), it is unlawful to attempt to identify a well as an orphan well by misrepresentation or failure to disclose all relevant facts.

"Where the department determines that a prior owner or operator received economic benefit, other than economic benefit derived only as a landowner or from a royalty interest, subsequent to April 18, 1979, from an orphan well or from a well which has not been registered, such owner or operator shall be responsible for plugging of the well." (58 P.S. 601.210(a))
